PACT ACT & VA BENEFITS



The full name of the law is The Sergeant First Class (SFC) Heath Robinson Honoring our Promise to Address Comprehensive Toxics (PACT) Act.

President Joe Biden signed The PACT Act into law August 8, 2020. This is a new law that expands VA health care and benefits for Veterans exposed to burn pits, Agent Orange, and other toxic substances. The PACT Act is probably one of the largest expansions in health care benefits for veterans.

The United States needs to be able to provide our Veterans and survivors the care and the benefits they deserve from their dedicated service. The PACT Act adds to the list of health conditions that we assume may be the cause of unsafe exposure to hazardous chemicals while serving their country.

What is Home Health Care?

Home healthcare is less expensive, more convenient and just as effective as spending time at the hospital or nursing facility. Home health covers a variety of illnesses or injuries that can be done right there in the patient's home.

Examples of services provided are:

- Monitoring illness and/or unstable health problems
- Patient/Caregiver education

Healthcare, please tell your doctor and they will assess if you need home healthcare. Your doctor should also have a listing of all the home healthcare organizations within your city. The doctor will have to send orders to the healthcare provider, then the home healthcare agency will schedule an appointment with you in your home. The agency will continue to speak with your doctor on your progress.

Patient Services from Healthcare provider:

- Take vital signs
- Check to make sure prescriptions are taken correctly
- Check to make sure patient is eating
- Ask questions related to any pain or problems
- Teach patient to care of themselves as best as possible
- Coordinate patient care with doctors and other caretakers
